SUBJECT: Coordination of Housing Privatization Initiatives with Boards for the Army and Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES), Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA), and Air Force Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR)

The purpose of this memo is to require coordination with the appropriate boards on issues relating to resale merchandise, services, and recreational operations or activities in conjunction with housing privatization initiatives. Basic policy in this area was set by SAF/MI memo, Housing Privatization Interim Operating Instructions, 2 Mar 99.

The housing privatization integrated process team (IPT) will surface any issues regarding resale merchandise, services, or recreational operations or activities in sufficient detail and with sufficient lead time to permit coordination with the respective boards before proceeding with the initiative. These issues include, but are not limited to:

- The continued operation of existing resale merchandise, services, or recreational operations or activities
- The need for additional resale merchandise, services, or recreational operations or activities
- The disposition of existing facilities constructed or improved with nonappropriated funds from AAFES or Services, or from commissary surcharge funds

AF/ILV is the Air Force liaison with AAFES and DeCA, and is the functional manager for the Air Force Services (MWR) program. As a member of the housing privatization IPT, AF/ILV will provide the necessary interface on AAFES, DeCA, and MWR issues as appropriate, and either obtain concurrence at the proper level or surface objections for resolution.
