

SUBJECT: Military Housing Privatization Initiative (MHPI) Portfolio Management Program

The Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Financial Management and Comptroller (SAF/FM) delegated AFCEE as the AF Portfolio Manager for privatized housing in February 2001. In that role, AFCEE has oversight and monitoring responsibility of all privatized projects as well as fiduciary responsibility for all direct and guaranteed loans made as a part of the MHPI program.

As Portfolio Manager, AFCEE has full authority to take whatever actions are necessary to perform all of its assigned responsibilities. AFCEE is authorized to coordinate with any Air Force, Department of Defense, or other offices as necessary in the performance of these duties to ensure compliance with project documents and to act in the best interests of the Air Force. This includes engaging in direct communications, both written and oral, with all commercial parties to privatized project transactions as deemed necessary. AFCEE will ensure that installation, MAJCOM, and Air Force level staffs are kept informed of all significant communications.

AFCEE is committed to providing the highest level of support to every MAJCOM and installation while at the same time fulfilling their AF Portfolio Management mission. We are committed to ensuring the appropriate level of oversight to the housing privatization program and request your support in providing AFCEE timely access to requested data.
